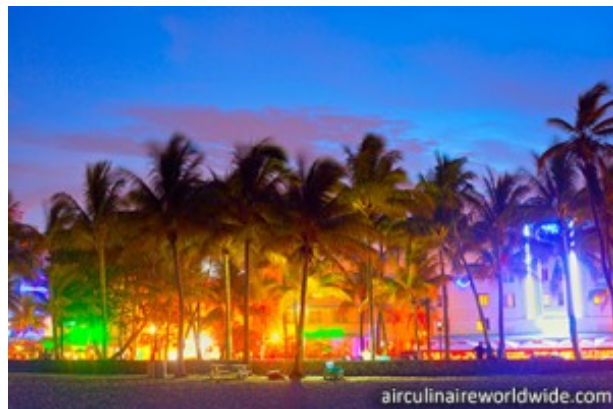


In-Flight Catering and Travel Tips for Miami, Florida
